

go2Gay privacy statement

We need your input in order to be able to offer you our go2Gay service.

For this reason, when you report a change, an addition or an assessment/review we must ask for your name and email address, data that we will hereinafter refer to as your privacy data.

You can find the current version of this privacy statement on www.go2gay.com.

The provider of the go2Gay services, Go2 Websolutions BV, will ensure that the privacy data that you supply does not come into the hands of third parties and is only used for the purchases specified below. The privacy data will be saved for a limited time. The actual storage period depends upon the purpose for which the data are collected, but this will never be longer than strictly necessary bearing in mind Dutch legislation and regulations.

Purpose of collection

Insufficient information to be able to process and/or place your message (posting).

Your privacy data enable us to contact you if you wish in order to obtain additional information from you on behalf of a stated change (posting). This only applies if the information (posting) we have received from you is insufficient for us to effect your posting and we require additional information from you. If you have specified that you do not wish to obtain any email, we reserve the right to refrain from processing the information and to remove the message (posting) from our system.

Doubts about the source

If necessary, your privacy data serve to verify the source of the information (posting). Normally such verification will not be done unless there is reason to doubt the reliability of the source. If you have stated that you do not wish to receive any email, we reserve the right to refrain from processing the information and to remove the message (posting) from our system.

Email to the email address that places the message (the posting)

On behalf of the above mentioned purposes, the go2Gay service may send an email to the email address published with the message, unless it was specifically stated at the posting that email is not wanted. In the latter case it is possible that for reasons of insufficient information processing/placement of the message (posting) is not possible.

If the recipient does not wish further email concerning the message (posting) that has been placed, there will be no further email communication with this person. The service reserves the right to refrain from further processing/placement of a message (posting) received by the service.

Privacy policy of the service go2Gay and the owner of the service Go2 Websolutions BV concerning your privacy data

Your privacy data:

- Are only relevant on behalf of the service for the above stated purposes and are no longer required by the service after their publication;
- Will not be stored for any longer than necessary to allow publication, unless Dutch law and regulations prescribe that the data must be stored longer. In that case, data will not be stored longer than the period stipulated by Dutch law and regulations;
- Can only be made accessible for the above stated data by the database administrator or the webmaster of the service for the above stated purposes;
- Will not in any way be accessible for users of the service unless you yourself have specified that certain privacy data may indeed be displayed;
- Will remain present in the database for a specific period if you have indicated that they may be displayed;
- Can be revoked at any time if you have specified that they may be displayed at any time by way of an email to info@go2gay.com. The relevant webmaster will then reverse the display as soon as possible but in any case, at the latest within 72 hours if possible;
- Will not be released to third parties in any manner whatsoever, unless:
 - o Go2 Websolutions BV is obliged to do so through legislation or the authorities;
 - o You authorise go2Gay service to use the privacy data that you have provided for a specific purpose by means of an option that you yourself have ticked.

Conditions of use

Please peruse the currently applicable conditions of use when you wish to place a message (posting). By acting according to the applicable conditions of use, you can prevent unwanted situations for yourself and for us.

If you have acted in breach of the conditions of use in effect at the time of the message (posting)

If, in good faith, we have placed information that you have provided and it later turns out that you have acted in breach of the conditions of use in effect at the time of the message (posting) such that third parties can utilise legal proceedings to enforce liability claims against the source for the consequences, the service or the owner of the service can be required by the authorities to reveal the source of the relevant data. Only in this case will we release your data to the relevant authorities.

Owners of an object

If you are the owner of an object, information concerning that object may be placed by you or a third party at the go2Gay service in order to make the object easy to find by users of the service.

As far as we can determine, all information published by the service concerning the object is public.

The service therefore assumes that the publication of the object will be to the benefit of your own objectives.

Your privacy is breached by the publication of an object

If you feel that the publication does not serve your objectives with regard to the object or that privacy sensitive material has become available that you do not wish to place with the go2Gay service, please inform us of this via info@go2gay.com. When doing this, specify the object clearly and make it entirely clear that you are the owner or the person authorised to act on behalf of the owner in the matter. State which information should be removed or that the entire object should be removed. You may, however, also place a change request at the detail page of the relevant object with a description of your reasons for the request. We will then revise the available information as soon as possible or remove the object from the database if that is your wish.

Your privacy is breached through the placement of an assessment (review)

Assessments can be placed by third parties that have visited a relevant object. These experiences are intended to encourage others to visit the object as well, but the experiences can also be critical if visitors were dissatisfied about the service or for some other reason. The go2Gay service will try to screen all of these incoming assessments as well as possible to ascertain that they are not in conflict with the applicable instructions for use. This is because the instructions for use are also intended to protect you as owner. Should you feel that, despite this careful screening, your **privacy** has been breached through a specific assessment, please let us know via info@go2gay.com. Clearly specify the relevant object, what assessment is concerned, and make it sufficiently clear that you are the owner or the person authorised to act on the owner's behalf. Specify which privacy information you feel should be removed or that the entire object should be removed.

Email to object owners

In order to keep the information provided by the service up to date, per time unit (this is per two or three months) the service sends an email to object owners with the request that they check the information related to the object. If you, as owner, do not wish these email sessions, you may always sign off from them by responding to the email with NO MAIL. We will then remove your registration and you will receive no further emails from the service.

The consequence of this is, however, that if they are not manually updated over a long period of time, your data will be removed and your object will no longer be visible to the users of the go2Gay service.

For the implementation of this activity the service is dependent upon the information in its possession. If the email address of the object known by the service or the email address of the owner is not correct, the email cannot be sent.

Response time to privacy data change requests

The service attempts to screen and process incoming requests as far as possible within 24 hours, and guarantees that it shall have screened and processed them within 72 hours, unless circumstances arise that are outside the realm of responsibility of the service. This might include servers or internet connections being down.

Storage period of privacy data

For the processing of messages (postings), the service has no interest in retaining privacy data longer than up to the moment at which a relevant message has been processed. Normally this processing takes place within 24 and 72 hours after placement of the message (posting). However, in view of the fact that you yourself are responsible for the publication of the message that you have placed, it is possible that according to Dutch legislation and regulations a longer storage period may be required. However, the storage period will never be longer than that established by law. An exception to this regulation is privacy data on which a provider has specified that they may be used for a specific purpose. In the context of that purpose, the relevant data are stored in order for the provider until he requests that they be removed. Unless a (different) storage period is stipulated by law, these data will then be removed from the go2Gay database.

Cookies

For the time being, the service does not use cookies and does not register the IP addresses of users. This may change, however, if and when the service is expanded, for example with new functionalities whereby user profiles are used. This privacy statement will be revised accordingly at that time.

Reporting updates

Unless it is specified that this is not desired, in the future the service will inform object owners and users requesting this via their own profile or otherwise of product updates by email.

Object owners and users can sign off from this service by replying to the email that they receive with NO MAIL.

Signing off regarding email receipt

All routine emails sent by the service specify the option of signing off regarding a relevant email by replying to the email received with NO MAIL. The service then sees to it that no further email is sent to the recipient from that time onward.
